WHEREAS , the Board of Education and the Westerville Education Association ("WEA") entered a collective bargaining agreement with effective dates of September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2012, and	
WHEREAS , the WEA has offered to assist the District address its financial needs by modifying certain terms of the current collective bargaining agreement as set forth herein,	
WHEREAS, with great appreciation the Board accepts the WEA's significant offer of assistance,	
NOW, THEREFORE , it is resolved that the collective bargaining agreement between the Board of Education and the WEA is modified as follows:	
salary. Th	$\frac{19.2.2}{10.00}$ – indicates that the salary increase for the 2011-12 school year is 1.75% increase on the base his provision is modified to reflect that the base salary increase shall be one-half (1/2) of the negotiated crease, or a 0.875% increase.
The second line in section 19.2.2 is changed to read: "Salary Index 1.00 = \$37,989 effective at the beginning of the 2011-12 school year.";	
schedule	$\frac{19.1}{19.1}$ – All employees who are eligible to receive a "Years of Service" step increase on the salary for the 2011-12 school year shall receive a step increase of one-half (1/2) of the amount of the step o which they would otherwise be entitled; and
	$\frac{19.2.5.1}{10.00}$ –Change Pay Plan A option from 26 pays to 24 pays upon the Treasurer's determination that ical to do so. The provision will be changed to read:
	9.2.5.1 PAY PLAN A – Twenty-four (24) equal installments, two (2) per month, beginning with the first egularly scheduled pay day in September through the following August.
All other provisions of the collective bargaining agreement between the Board of Education and the WEA remain as written.
